

CAPD VIRTUAL TRAINING | SUPPORTING NON-RENAL STAFF

During this COVID-19 crisis Baxter realise that some treatment of chronic renal and acute kidney injury patients might require some innovative approaches. Continuous Ambulatory Peritoneal Dialysis (CAPD) is a simple to perform renal replacement therapy which could be utilised by non-renal staff to treat people with renal impairment whilst they are inpatients during this pandemic. Therefore, Baxter Renal Therapy Specialists are running several times a week, a standardised CAPD training programme to be run virtually via WebEx / webinar format.

These sessions will run as hourly sessions during the week at a variety of different times and dates to try to accommodate different shift patterns and to meet the needs of as many staff as possible. NHS staff can dial in to these sessions when they have some available time.

The sessions will include basic theory alongside practical teaching about how to do a CAPD exchange. The teaching materials including a PDF version of the CAPD exchange procedure will be made available for use so hospitals can print and utilise them as needed. In addition the sessions will be recorded and available to access at other times.
